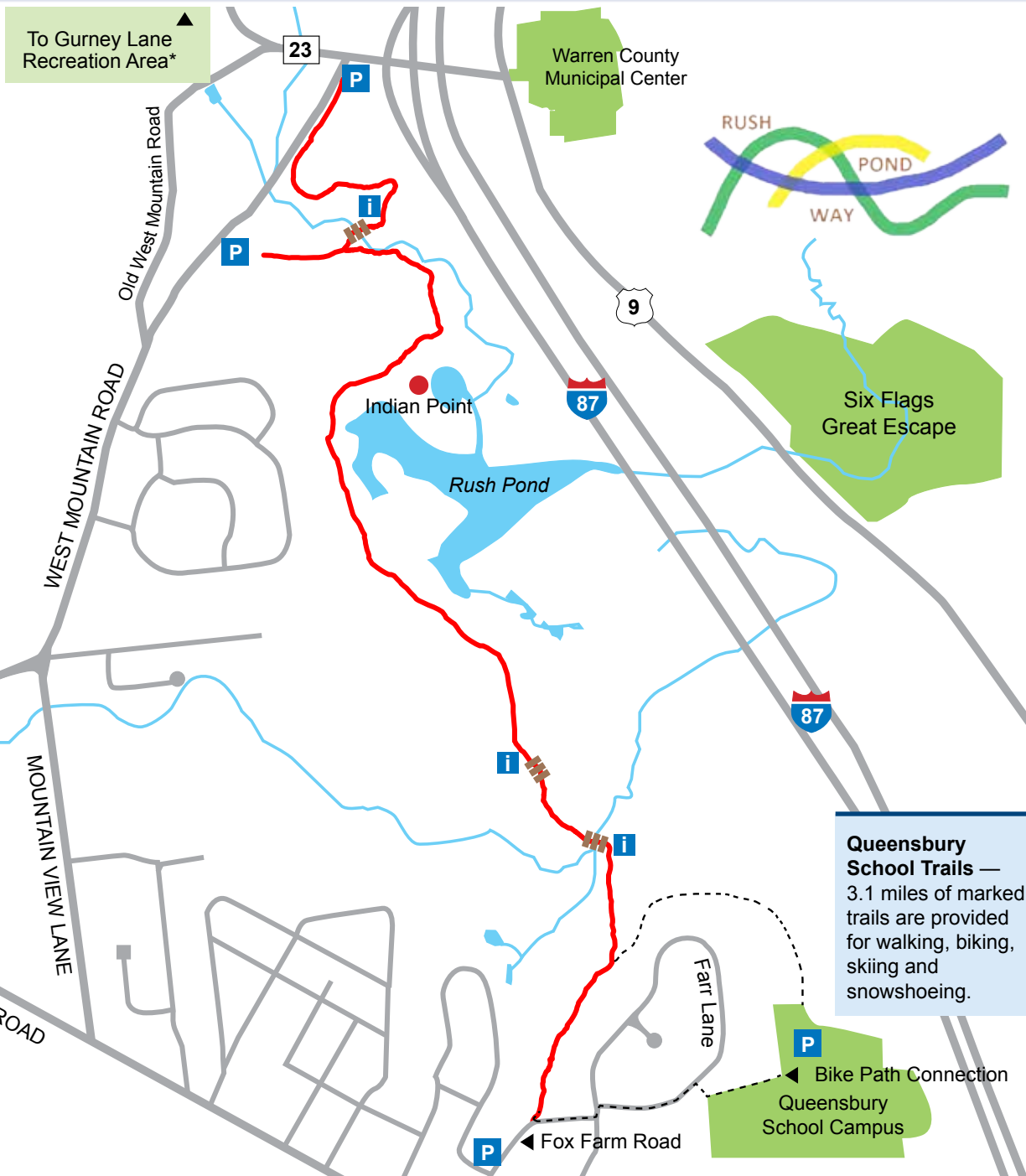

TRAIL USER NOTE: The **Gurney Lane Recreation Area** is a 150+ acre park located just north of Rush Pond Way and offers many miles of additional trails for year-round use. Trail heads can be accessed via the main entrance (118 Gurney Lane) or via Carol Thomas Way (right turn after intersection of West Mountain Road and Gurney Lane) — parking area at top of hill.
